I. Purpose

To assist members of Flat Springs Baptist Church and others of the greater church community in their time of need.

II. Definitions

The Local Missions Committee - members of Flat Springs Baptist Church selected by the Nominating Committee and approved by the church members.

III. Procedure

1. Committee members to serve from September 1 through August 31 of each church year.
2. Members of this committee are to elect a Chairperson at the initial meeting of every church year.
3. This committee is funded by:
 - a. an appropriation that is determined by the Finance Committee and approved by the members in conference assembly. (Prior to the beginning of each new church year.)
 - b. offerings designated specifically for local missions.

IV. Responsibilities

1. It is the Chairperson's responsibility to communicate with each committee member whenever a need is presented to this committee for consideration.
2. All needs brought to this committee's attention are to be dealt with in a discrete, sensitive, confidential and respectful manner.
