## Happy $136^{\text {th }}$ Birthday to Women's Missionary Union



With a membership of approximately 1 million, WMU has become the largest Protestant missions organization for women in the world. WMU's main purpose is to educate and involve adults, youth, children, and preschoolers in the cause of Christian missions. Although originally geared towards women, girls, and preschoolers, both genders and multiple cultures are active participants in WMU organizations and ministries today.

In May 1888, a movement began in the hearts of a group of women in a church basement with ripples ever since. This group vowed to take up missions on the home front and abroad. During the meeting of the Southern Baptist Convention in Richmond, Virginia, a group of women delegates from 12 states gathered at the Broad Street United Methodist Church and organized the "Executive Committee of the Woman's Mission Societies," an auxiliary group to the Southern Baptist Convention. Annie Armstrong was elected as the first corresponding secretary. Conversation inevitably led to the trials and joys that Lottie Moon (1840-1912) was experiencing in China, where she served as missionary for forty years (1873-1912).

For 136 years, the offerings of women and girls have led to unknown numbers of prayers raised, training materials and curricula being written and published, and millions of dollars raised to support Southern Baptist missions work. Today, WMU is headquartered in Birmingham, Alabama.

On May 14, WMU will celebrate Founders Day in a public way to inspire missions-minded Christians to share the gospel of Jesus Christ at home and with the world. Individually and
 together, let's make Jesus known! Thus, is the Great Commission.
