I. Purpose

To minister to our congregation, community and area churches in Sanford, NC (especially children) with the use of puppets by puppeteer committee members.

II. Definitions

The Puppet Committee – members of Flat Springs Baptist Church selected by the Nominating Committee and approved by the Church membership.

- III. Procedure & Responsibilities
 - 1. Committee members to serve from September 1 through August 31 of each church year.
 - 2. Puppeteers must attend practices before performing at puppet shows and conduct themselves in a mature manner.
 - 3. Puppeteers must take care of puppets at all times. After performances, puppets need to be put in puppet room and hung on the pegs.
 - 4. Stage, props, tapes, C D's, sound systems, etc. must be put in puppet room after performances.
 - 5. Puppeteer must be mature to man a puppet.
 - 6. Props, scenery etc. take hours of preparation. These need to be handled and stored in puppet room so they can be used again.
 - 7. Puppet room needs to be locked at all times.
 - 8. Youth using puppets need to have an adult to take responsibility for the puppets, tapes, and props and properly store them in puppet room and lock after use.
