I. Purpose

The Senior Adult Ministry Committee (SAM) was established to minister to all senior adults, while focusing on nursing home and homebound residents of our church members and their extended families. We strive to assess the needs of the elderly and relay those needs to the appropriate group.

II. Definition

Senior Adult Committee – are members of Flat Springs Baptist Church who voluntarily serve and are approved by the church. It is funded by designated monetary gifts.

III. Procedure

- A. Committee members to server from September 1 through August 31 of each church year.
- B. The SAM Committee will meet monthly to plan senior activities.
- C. Periodically, we will visit nursing home residents, homebound residents, and other health-impaired seniors.
- D. We will organize functions for seniors such as luncheons, nursing home visits, mission projects, and other activities for fellowship and nurturing.

IV. Responsibilities

- A. Assess needs of seniors and relay those needs to the appropriate group.
