All of this work gives the Pastor Search Committee (or Pulpit Committee) a strong start. But this committee cannot begin their work until they have 3 important profiles in hand – a church profile, community profile and pastor profile.

When the Pastor Search Committee interviews a candidate, he will want to know what the church looks like, what the community looks like and what kind of pastor you need. So, these profiles are extremely important!

The church is grateful for everyone who has invested their time in the work thus far. Thank you to everyone who has prayed for the people serving on these 5 teams, also.

If you have not been involved in or supportive of this process, now is the time to get on board. The church needs to be the church <u>together</u>. That will certainly influence your next pastor's decision to come to Flat Springs.

Your prayers are more important than ever. Pray for the Future Team and for the selection of the Pastor Search Committee. Pray for your next pastor. Remember, "to whom much has been given, much is required." (Luke 12:48)
