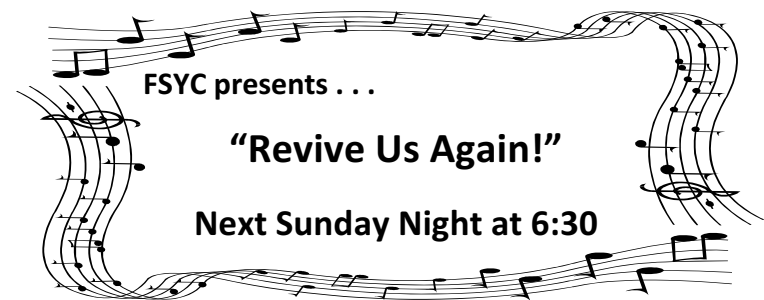

At the conclusion of the Morning Worship, the church will be asked by ballot vote to extend the call to Taylor to become our Associate Pastor of Family Ministry.
