Place bags of individually wrapped candy in small kitchen until October 22<sup>th</sup>.

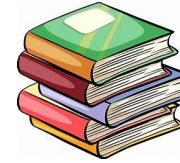

- Website: [flatspringsbaptist.com](http://flatspringsbaptist.com) click on the **Give Now** button at the top right of the homepage
- App Giving – Download REALM Connect from the App Store. Set up a Realm account with your personal and giving information.
- Text Giving – Text the keyword FLATSPRINGS (no space, not case sensitive) to 73256, which also spells Realm. Follow the prompts on your phone. You may now choose to give to either General Offering funds or NC Missions. Enter your payment amount and your card information.

## WORLD HUNGER OFFERING MONTH OF OCTOBER



The scale of the current global hunger and malnutrition crisis is enormous. A shocking 37.2 million people face emergency levels of hunger, while 1.3 billion people are in the grips of catastrophic hunger. Many food crises involve multiple overlapping issues driving hunger, that are building year after year. The interplay between conflict, economic shocks, inflation and the impact of drought is vital to understanding the scale of the challenge. The world is at risk of yet another year of record hunger as the global food crisis continues to drive more people into worsening levels of acute food insecurity. This massive global crisis requires a global response.

**World Food Day** is celebrated annually on October 16 to promote global awareness and action for those who suffer from hunger, and to highlight the need to ensure healthy diets for all.

**How You Can Help** - Flat Springs will be collecting donations for World Hunger the entire month of October. If you have a bread basket, you may bring it to the Sunday School office or the church office. Be sure to write down the number of the bread basket and your name.
