WORLD HUNGER OFFERING MONTH OF OCTOBER

The scale of the current global hunger and malnutrition crisis is enormous. A shocking 37.2 million people face emergency levels of hunger, while 1.3 million people are in the grips of catastrophic hunger. Many food crises involve multiple overlapping issues driving hunger, that



are building year after year. The interplay between conflict, economic shocks, inflation and the impact of drought is vital to understanding the scale of the challenge. The world is at risk of yet another year of record hunger as the global food crisis continues to drive more people into worsening levels of acute food insecurity. This massive global crisis requires a global response.

World Food Day is celebrated annually on October 16 to promote global awareness and action for those who suffer from hunger, and to highlight the need to ensure healthy diets for all.
