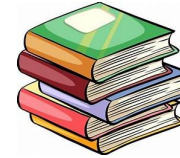

Highway to Healing is a nonprofit organization consisting of a group of volunteers who help Lee County cancer patients by driving them to and from cancer treatment appointments. Most appointments are in Sanford, Pinehurst and Chapel Hill but can also be in Durham, Raleigh, or Fayetteville. There is no cost to the patients. Volunteers are asked to drive at least once a month, but may drive as many times as their schedule allows. Volunteers pick their destination and are compensated for their gas in cooperation with local gas stations.

## WORLD HUNGER OFFERING MONTH OF OCTOBER

The scale of the current global hunger and malnutrition crisis is enormous. A shocking 37.2 million people face emergency levels of hunger, while 1.3 billion people are in the grips of catastrophic hunger.
