In the Scriptures

John 7:2 Now the Jewish Feast of Tabernacles was near.

Leviticus 23:39 On exactly the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the crops of the land, you shall celebrate the feast (of Tabernacles) to the LORD for seven days, with a rest on the first day and a rest on the eighth day. 40 Now on the first day you shall take for yourselves the foliage of beautiful trees, palm branches and boughs of leafy trees and willows of the brook; and you shall rejoice before the LORD your God for seven days. 42 'You shall live in booths for seven days; all the native-born in Israel shall live in booths, 43 so that your generations may know that I had the sons of Israel live in booths when I brought them out from the land of Egypt. I am the LORD your God."

Zechariah 14:16 Then it will come about that any who are left of all the nations that went against Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles.

Isaiah 12:3 With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

Isaiah 44:3 For I will pour out water on the thirsty land and streams on the dry ground; I will pour out My Spirit on your offspring and My blessing on your descendants.

John 7:37 Now on the last day, the great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink. 38 He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water." 39 But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

Feast of Tabernacles Terms

Hoshienu — Hosanna, means "Save us now" from Psalm 118:25

Hallel — means "Praise", the Hallel Psalms are 113-118

Hoshanna Raba — The 7th Day, or Great Day of the Feast, (John 7:37)

Lulav — made of Palm, Willow, and Myrtle branches, ceremonially waved as part of the Feast of Tabernacles celebration (Lev. 23:40)

Sukkah — Booth or tabernacle, a temporary structure (Lev. 23:42)

Sukkot — Feast of Booths or Tabernacles (literally, plural of sukkah)
