goods (cake, pies, or cookies) for the cake walk.



40 Days of Pray

Pastor Search Committee asks you to join us in entering 40 days of daily scripture reading and prayer as we seek the Lord during our Pastor Search process. Scripture records many times how people set aside 40 days prayer and seeking the Lord:

- Moses on the mountain with God for 40 days before he brought down the 10 Commandments (Exodus 34)
- The prophet Elijah sought the Lord for 40 days (I Kings 19)
- 40 days is the example Jesus set in Matthew 4:1-11. Before He began His ministry, He went into the wilderness for 40 days and 40 nights, praying and fasting.

The goal in this process is prayerful, dependence, practicing prayer together, fully dependent on the Lord, who is head of the church. He knows the way, and every circumstance that will impact the way. He will show the way by his grace if we follow his lead, his timing, his word to the discovery of his perfect will. Daily prayer guides are available in print and have been sent by email.
